**Sutter Pacific Medical Foundation Plans New Care Centers in San Francisco Neighborhoods**  
*Primary Care and Integrated Health Services Will Be Offered*

(San Francisco, Aug. 3, 2016) – Sutter Pacific Medical Foundation, part of the not-for-profit Sutter Health network, is opening new medical care centers in the busy SOMA and Mission District neighborhoods in San Francisco—creating convenient healthcare options for people who live and work in the area.

The first care center opened at 8 a.m. on Monday, Aug. 1 at 55 Second St. in SOMA, the South of Market street neighborhood next to San Francisco’s Financial District.

This new local facility brings primary care for adults and integrated healthcare services under one roof including acupuncture, nutrition, chiropractic care, imaging, as well as an onsite laboratory to the neighborhood and surrounding businesses. The care center also will be offering a travel medicine clinic. More specialty services are planned.

A second medical care center at 899 Valencia St. in the heart of the Mission District neighborhood will open in mid-November. The Valencia Street Care Center will offer adult and pediatric primary care services, laboratory and imaging services, integrative health services and a health and healing retail store.

The care centers will bring needed primary care services to neighborhoods with growing populations, giving individuals easy access to Sutter Health specialists. Their close proximity to the CPMC St. Luke’s campus supports a range of healthcare services for neighborhoods in the southern sector of San Francisco. The design of both care centers takes into account the unique needs of local consumers while maintaining the commitment to deliver high-quality, high-touch care.

“We are excited and ready to offer trusted, top-notch care to people in these two vibrant neighborhoods,” said Toni Brayer, M.D., CEO of Sutter Pacific Medical Foundation. “We look forward to making excellent services available that are tailored to the needs of consumers.”

Patients at these care centers will have access to My Health Online, Sutter Health’s personal health tool that allows patients to manage their health online, email their doctors, renew prescriptions, view test results, schedule appointments and pay their bills.

The care centers are near public transportation routes. Parking garages near the 55 Second Street Care Center include a garage beneath the building with access from Anthony Street, off Mission Street, and Towne Park garage at 85 Second St. with access at 590 Mission St.
